Guidelines for Weekly Service:

- Weekly pickup is Friday. If a holiday falls on a Monday-Friday, collection will be delayed ONE DAY following the holiday. If the holiday falls on a Saturday or Sunday, collection will not be affected.
- Trash should be placed in plastic bags or receptacle/can of 35 gallons or less, weighing less than 35 pounds.
- Trash and recyclables must be in separate containers; they may not be comingled.
- Place all materials curbside by 6:00 a.m. as truck routes and pickup times may change.
- Additional recycling bins are available from Town Hall for \$10/bin.

Recyclable	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Cardboard and boxboard must be flattened and tied in 3'x 4' bundles. Keep dry.• Glass must be clean and unbroken. Labels may be on.• Lead Acid Batteries• Newspaper, magazines, catalogs and office paper – bundled or contained in a box or grocery bag. Keep dry. May place next to bin.• Paint (empty cans or dried contents).• Plastics with recycling symbols 1 through 7; rinsed.• Tin cans, rinsed.• Aerosol cans, empty.• Aluminum cans and foil, rinsed. <p><i>No</i> empty plastic bags. They should be recycled at stores. <i>No</i> Styrofoam; not recyclable. <i>No</i> hard plastic buckets.</p>
Trash	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Curtain rods and wire hangers• Non-recyclable glass – mirrors, ceramic cups and plates, clay flower pots, crystal, light bulbs, window glass, heat-resistant ovenware and drinking glass. Please wrap broken glass before placing in the trash.• Styrofoam and hard plastic buckets.

<p>Spring Cleanup</p> <p>6/10/2023</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Carpet and padding in 4'x 2' bundles, tied securely • Furniture • General household trash • Mattresses and box springs <p>Please do not save up regular trash in anticipation of this date. Springdale is charged by the pound for anything picked up for Spring Cleanup. Additionally, if a rainy day, please cover anything that might absorb water. NO RECYCLABLES ACCEPTED. Thank you!</p>
<p>NEVER ACCEPTED</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Automotive parts and batteries • Brush/yard waste • Concrete, asphalt or bricks • Construction materials • Fluorescent light fixtures • Gas tanks and gas cans • Hazardous or toxic waste materials • Infectious waste • Oil filters and oil absorbents – take to Safety-Kleen, 3715 Lexington Ave., Madison (608) 241-3883 • Wood burner or fireplace ash (fire hazard!) • Wood pallets

Common reasons for missed collections: refuse is placed *after* designated collection time, trash/recycles outside of bins, or contains unacceptable items such as listed above.
