Dear Ms. Tanchester:

On April 9, 2020 American Transmission Company LLC (ATC) filed an application with the Public Service Commission of Wisconsin (Commission) for authority to construct and place into operation a new 138 kilovolt transmission line from the Hooterville Substation to the Mount Horeb Substation to interconnect a new Wisconsin Power and Light Company substation to be near the Village of Barneveld, near the Village of Mount Horeb, Dane and Iowa Counties, Wisconsin. The application was filed pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 196.491(3) and Wis. Admin. Code § PSC 111.53, which requires the Commission to determine whether a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity should be granted.

The Commission and the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources reviewed the application to construct the facilities described above. Based on this review, the Commission has determined that the application is complete and, by this letter, notifies ATC of this determination as required by Wis. Stat. § 196.491(3)(a)2.


The day after the date of this letter is the first day of the Commission's 180-day review period under Wis. Stat. § 196.491(3)(g). Please be aware that application information that is considered adequate with this determination may require further development later in the Commission's review process. This additional information may be required to complete the record from which the Commission will make its decision whether to approve the application under Wis. Stat. § 196.491(3)(d). Such additional information may relate to engineering, environmental, and other issues. When such issues arise, Commission staff will promptly issue a data request for the specific information needed. Immediate responses by ATC to additional data requests are imperative to avoid delays in the Commission's review of the project.

Ms. Carolyn Tanchester  
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Wisconsin Stat. § 196.491(3)(a)2. requires the Commission to send an electronic copy of the complete application to the clerk of each municipality and town in which the proposed facilities are to be located and to the main public library in each such county. The copies must be distributed not more than 10 days after the application is found complete. Wisconsin Admin Code § PSC 111.51(4)(b)3. allows the Commission to direct the applicant to send the electronic copies of the application. By this letter, the Commission directs ATC to send electronic copies of the complete application to the local government and library locations. Further, please provide to the Commission an electronic MS Word file of the application.

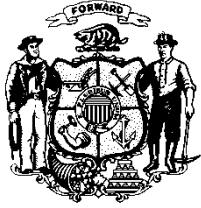
